The court has reviewed the plaintiff's Motion for Service of Process by Publication and Affidavit, and the plaintiff's verified Complaint for Divorce. It appears that 1) service of process upon the defendant has not been completed and cannot now be completed by personal service, 2) the complaint states a cause of action against the defendant and the defendant is a necessary and proper party to this action, and 3) the newspaper listed in the plaintiff's affidavit is the newspaper in which publication is most likely to give notice to the defendant. Service of process by publication and mail is proper pursuant to Idaho Code §§ 5-508, 5-509, and I.R.C.P. 4(e)(1).

Therefore, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that

1. The plaintiff will serve process on the defendant by publishing the Summons in this case in _____ newspaper,

in the County of _____, City of _____, State of _____, at least once per week for four consecutive weeks. The Summons to be published must contain a statement in general terms of the nature of the plaintiff's claim against the defendant.

2. When publication is completed, the plaintiff will file with the court an affidavit of publication, verifying publication of the Summons in accordance with this order.

3. The plaintiff will mail a true copy of the Complaint for Divorce, Summons, and Joint Preliminary Injunction in this case to the defendant. The plaintiff will mail the copies to the defendant's last known address, which is _____

The plaintiff will mail the copies no later than ten days after the first publication of the Summons.

4. After the plaintiff has mailed the copies to the defendant, the plaintiff will promptly file with the court an affidavit of service, verifying service of process by mail in accordance with this order.
